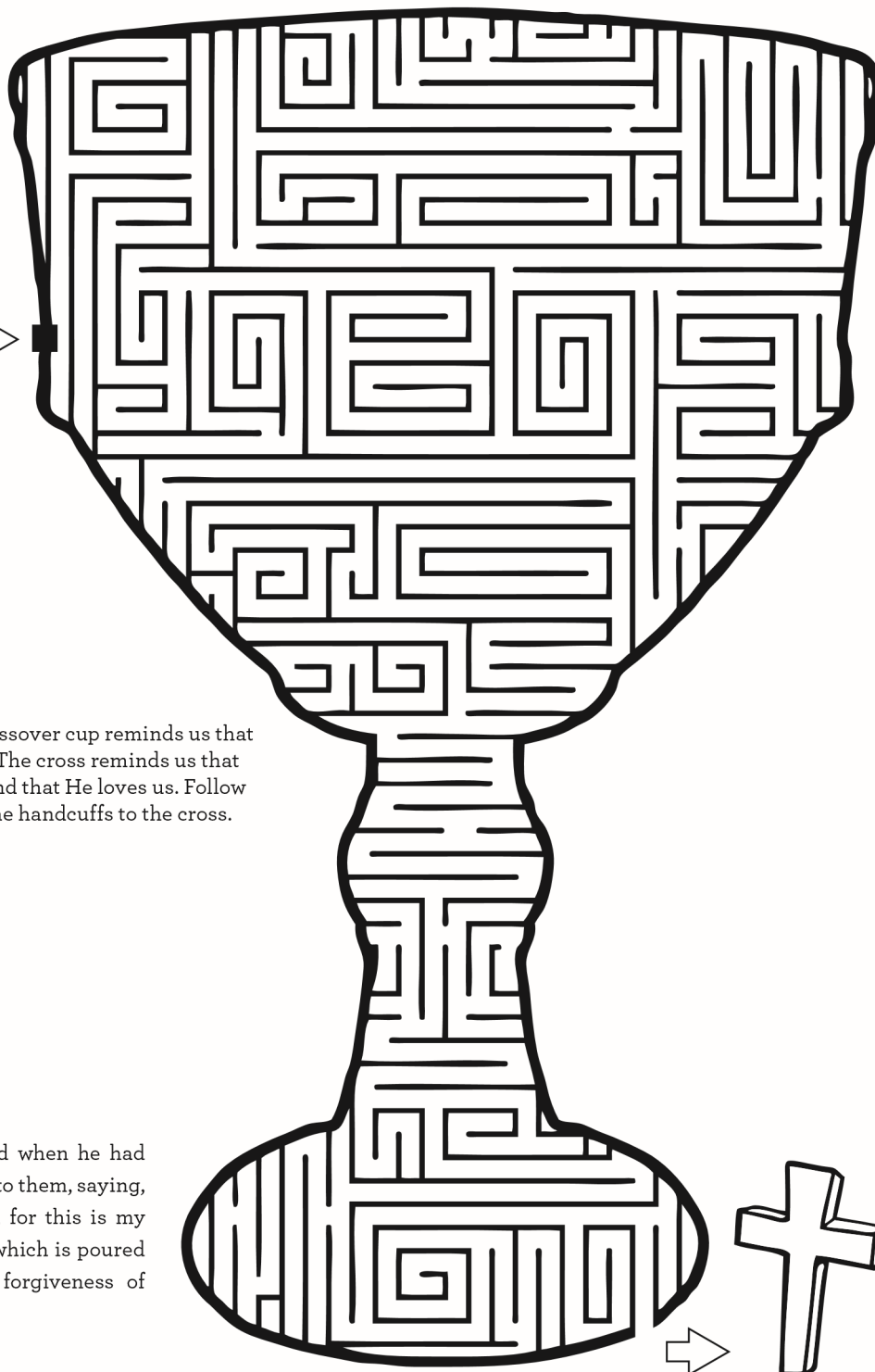
# The Cup

—Matthew 26:27-28

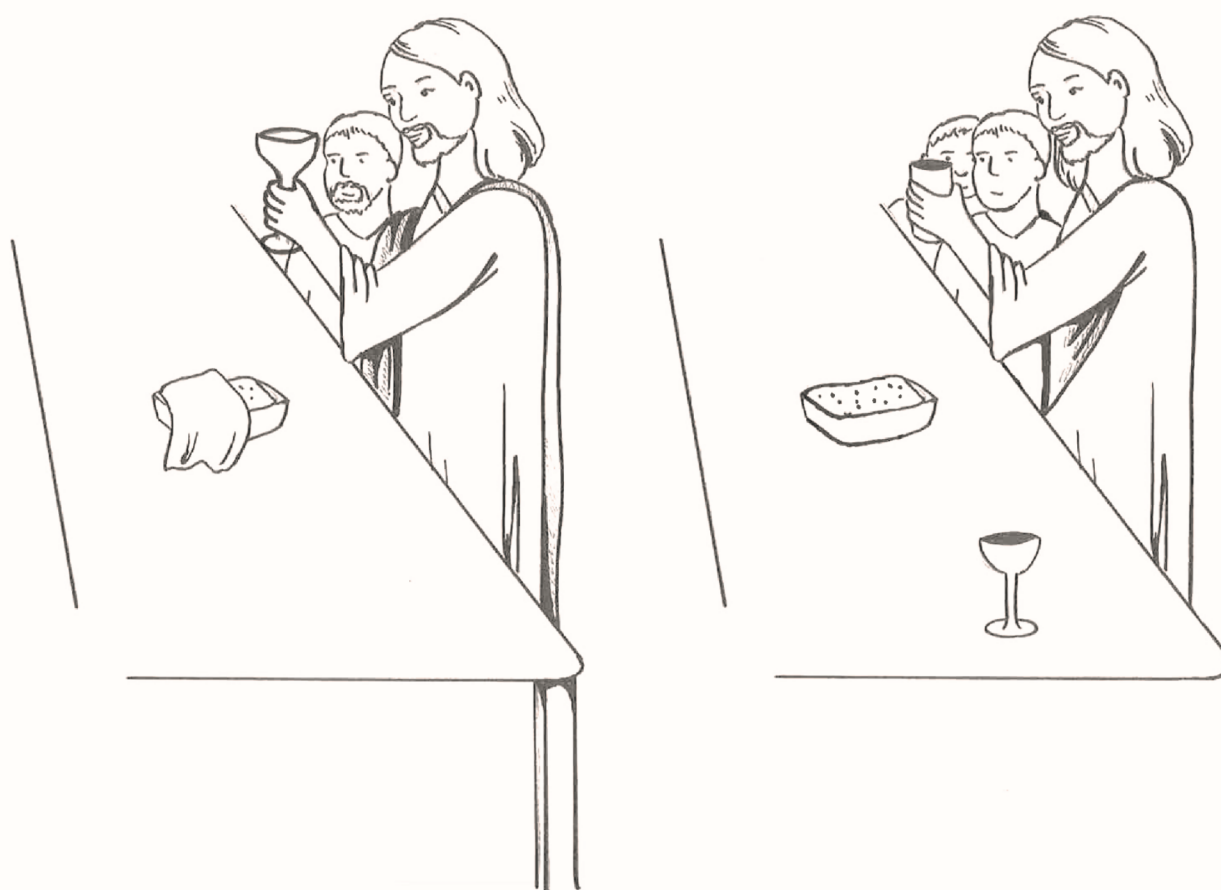

**DIRECTIONS:** Circle 10 differences in these two pictures.



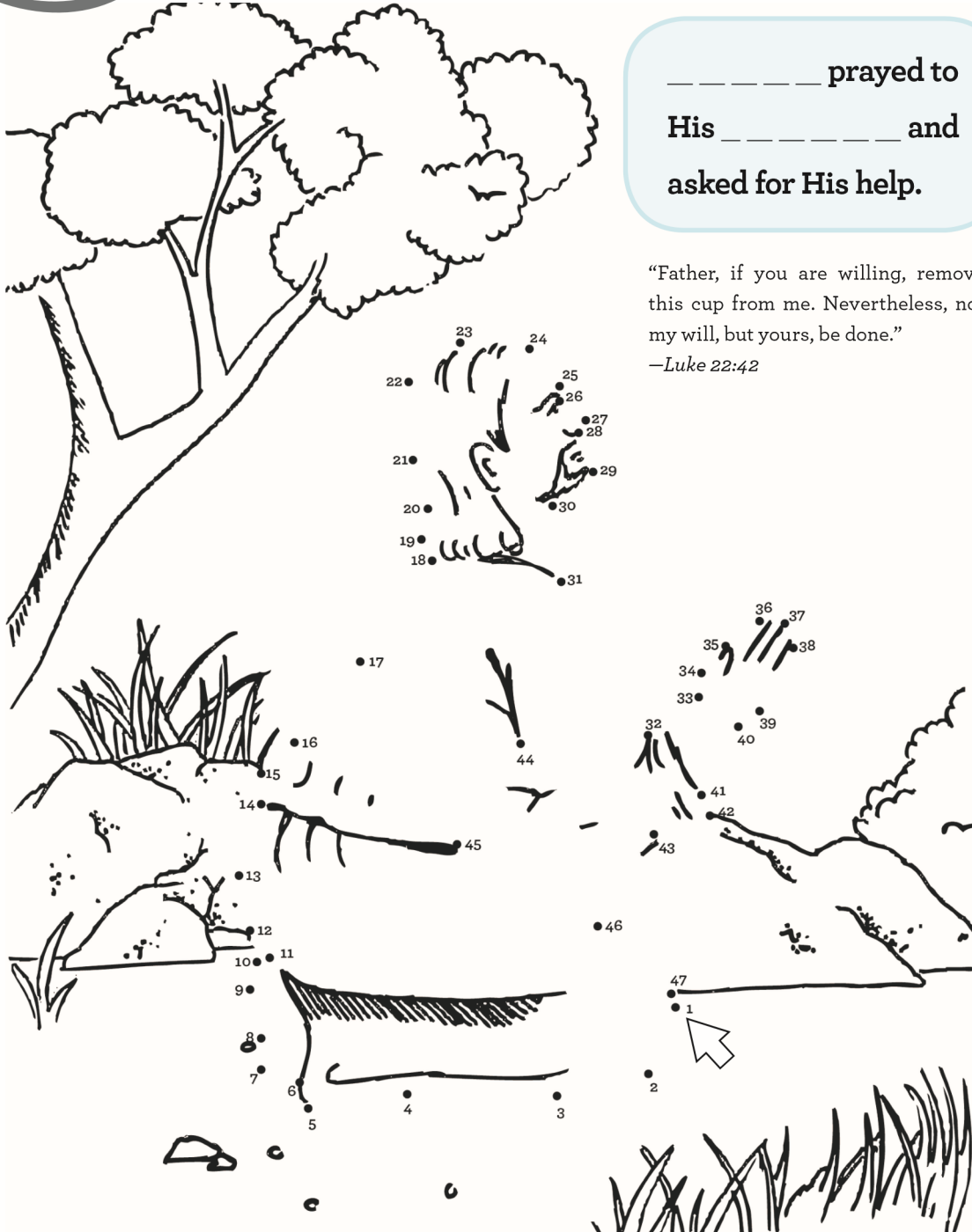
